## Article in today's Australian Financial Review

AIX notes the comments in today's Australian Financial Review (AFR) attributed to Jetstar CEO Bruce Buchanan in relation to pricing negotiations with Darwin International Airport (DIA).

The pricing agreement between DIA and the airlines that use the airport expired on 30 June 2009. Temporary pricing arrangements are currently in place. Prior to and since the expiry of the pricing agreement, senior executives from DIA have negotiated with Jetstar and other airlines towards fair and reasonable pricing that will provide a fair and reasonable return on the capital invested by DIA at the airport.

DIA senior executives will continue to make themselves available to negotiate directly with Jetstar and other airlines that use the airport and remain hopeful that a reasonable outcome for all parties will be achieved.

AIX owns 28.2 percent of DIA, through its ownership of NT Airports, which represents 5.4 percent of the AIX portfolio by value.


